

“Made in Greene County” Showcase Vendor Information

- All booths are only available to those who have products made in Greene County.
- Vendor space is limited and provided on a first-come, first-serve basis to eligible vendors.
- Registrations must be submitted through the online registration site. Online registration will be closed approximately 3 weeks prior to the event.
- All products sold at the event must be made in Greene County, Indiana and only these types of vendors will be permitted to sell. No Avon, Tastefully Simple, Thirty-One, Scentsy, Tupperware, or any other home consultants. No crafts made by hot-gluing two or more products purchased from a craft store. No retail, no re-sell, no antiques, etc... This is not a yard sale. **To uphold the primary purpose of the event, GCTAB and its volunteers reserves the right to request vendors to remove ineligible items from their booth spaces at any time during the event or during vendor set-up times.**
- Food vendors selling items made in your home kitchen must have clear signage at their booth that states, **“Made in Home Kitchen”** and accept any liability for those items sold. Food Vendors may only sell cold items and no drinks. Hot foods and drinks are exclusive to the Greene County Homemakers at the Concession Stand. Please support them!
- All vendors must provide everything for their booth. This includes tables, chairs, change, extension cords, power strips, or anything else required to display and sell your items. **WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PROVIDE ANY OF THESE ITEMS.**
- Vendor set-up time will be 6pm-8pm the Friday evening prior to the event and 7am-9am Saturday morning the day of the event. All vendors should be completely set-up and ready to sell by 9am when the doors open to the public. Vendors must remain open through the entire event and should not begin packing up their booths until 3pm when the event closes. All vendors must have all belongings removed from the facility no later than 4:30pm on the day of the event.
